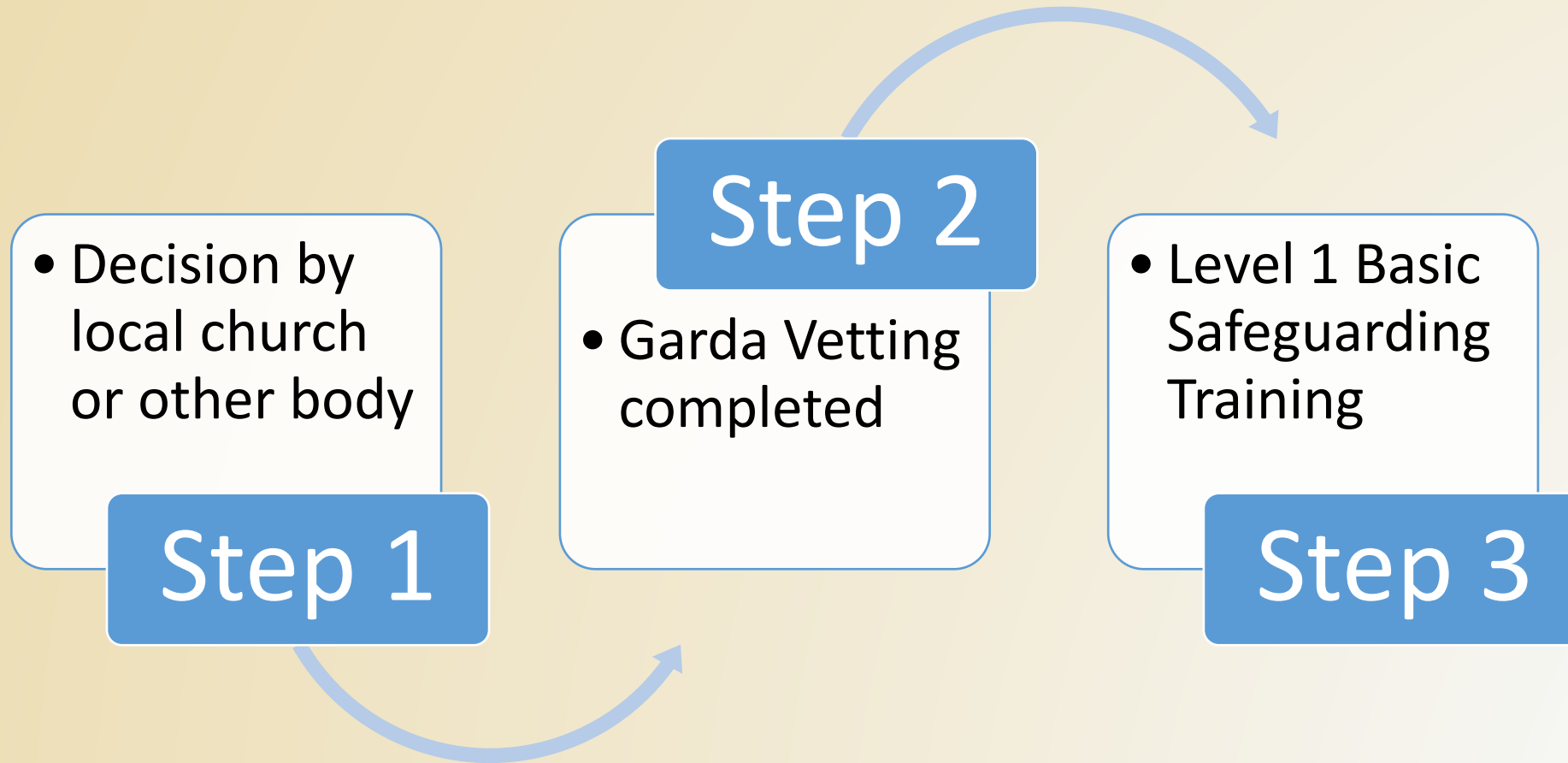

Recruitment Process



Level 1 Basic Safeguarding Training

- What is Level 1 Basic Safeguarding Training?
 - Children First E-Learning Programme
 - <https://www.tusla.ie/children-first/children-first-e-learning-programme/>
- Wasn't previously mandatory
- Organisation: must provide some kind of training
- In future – training will need to be upgraded
- No legislation regarding how long training lasts for
- Best practice – 3 years from certificate date
- Please work towards getting individuals to update certs regularly
- New authorisation to work with children/vulnerable adults will not be given until Vetting & Training are completed



Who should be vetted & do training?

Key Question –

- *Will the person be in a position **to build a relationship of trust** with a child or vulnerable adult, including via electronic means?*



If the answer is YES then vetting is mandatory.



Vetting Expiry

- Communication from SDCVC (mid- to end 2020)
- Still going through committee & Oireachtas
- Likely: Autumn 2021
- Start re-vetting now
- Can still work even after 3 years

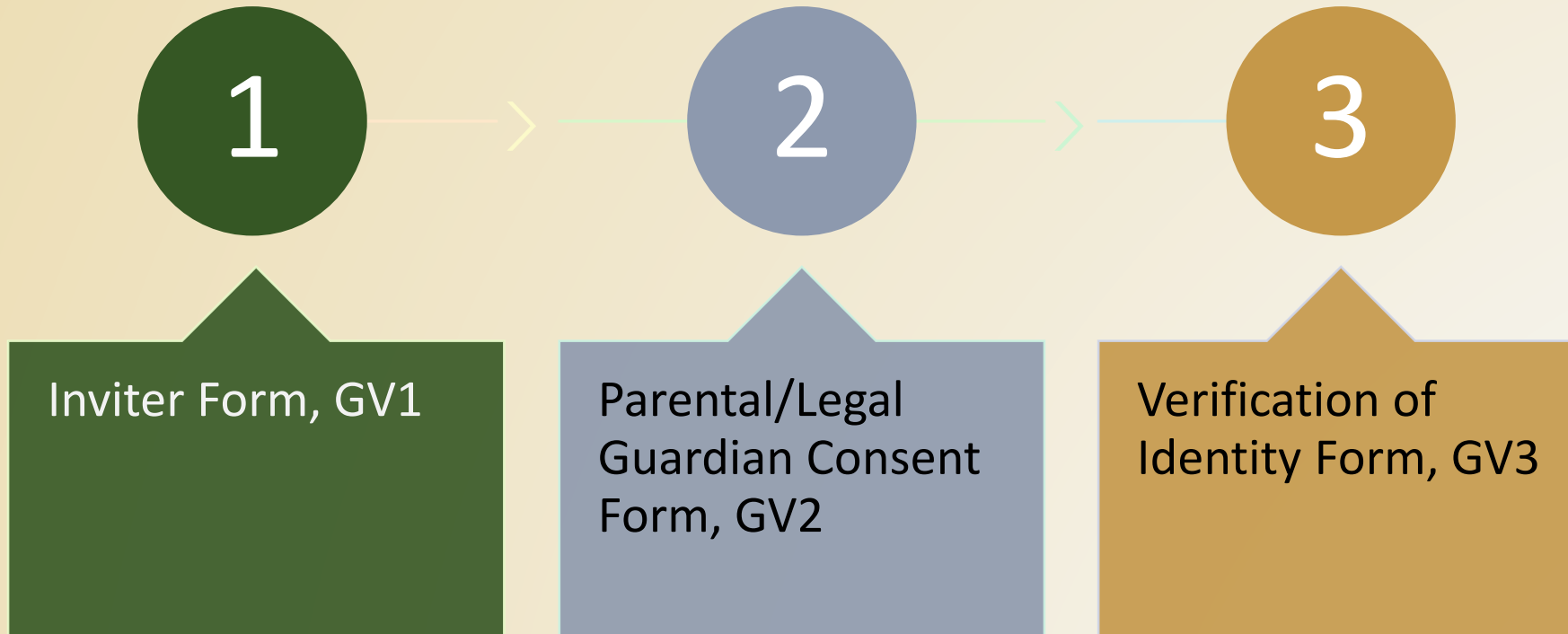

- GV3 – sending too many documents through!

Check, check Check!



GV3 Verification of Identity Form updates

No mobile phone bills

Passport (6 weeks) – not best practise
